

OVERVIEW



In 1975, BDPA, formerly known as *Black Data Processing Associates*, was co-founded in Philadelphia, PA by Earl A. Pace, Jr. and the late David Wimberly. The association's co-founders cited a lack of minorities in middle and upper management, low recruitment in underserved communities, and very poor preparation of minorities for new "data processing" and tech positions, resulting in an overall lack of career mobility known by many today as the "Digital Divide". Today, BDPA's mission partners, new BDPA Members, National BDPA High School Computer Competition (HSCC) alumni, and tech industry stakeholders have increased their participation and investments with BDPA. This is accomplished by developing new talent acquisition strategies while improving tech-inclusion thrusts with local BDPA Chapters and regional outreach engagements. 
